*The fees include tuition fees, hot lunches, after school clubs, wrap around care from 08.00 till 18.00 and one educational school trip / workshop per term. Also included are all class tuition exercise books, library books and basic stationery. All on-site sports and equipment and travel to and from school matches are included.

- All fees are payable by:
 - 2nd September – Autumn Term
 - 2nd January – Spring Term
 - 2nd April – Summer Term
- Fees are subject to alteration and an annual increase should be expected.
- Parents may pay fees monthly by direct debit using School Fee Plan, by cheque or BACS. (See Bursar for further details).
- No reduction is made for absence.

Admission Fee:

An Admission Fee of £300 is due to reserve your child's place at Lyndhurst which is non-refundable.

Discounts:

Sibling Discount – 10% second child and 15% third and subsequent children

OR

Service Discount – 10% first child and 15% for second and subsequent children

NOTES FOR EARLY YEARS

- (1) Pre-Reception is open Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm.

08.30 – 12.00 Morning session

12.00 – 13.00 includes hot lunch. Own packed lunches can be brought in but we are unable to offer a discount (does not count as a morning or afternoon session).

13.00 – 16.30 Afternoon session

Any additional sessions will be charged as follows:

- (2) For Pre-Reception children the minimum number of sessions is 5; these can be a mixture of morning and afternoons.

(3) **15 hours Early Education Grant:**

Children who are 3 or 4 years old are eligible for a maximum of 3 hours per day (15 hours per week) part-funding from the Government (Early Years Education Grant) which is approximately £664 per term, if 5 morning sessions are attended. (This is an average figure as the actual figure is dependent on the number of days in a term). This applies for up to six terms commencing the term following their 3rd birthday.

30 hours Early Education Grant:

Children who are 3 or 4 years old may be eligible for a maximum of 6 hours per day, 3 in the morning session and 3 in the afternoon session (30 hours per week) part-funding from the Government (Early Years Education Grant) which is approximately £1,328 per term, if 5 morning and 5 afternoon sessions are attended. (This is an average figure as the actual figure is dependent on the number of days in a term). This applies for up to six terms commencing the term following their 3rd birthday.

(5) **Tax- Free Childcare**

Lyndhurst School accept payments from the Tax-Free Childcare Scheme.

(6) **Notice periods:**

Please note that

- two terms' notice is required to leave the school for any pupil within Pre-Reception
- one term notice is required to leave the school for pupils in Reception – Y6
- half term notice is required for cancelling confirmed optional classes (e.g. 1-1 Music lessons)
