SPELLING

- Create a poster to show groups of homophones using letters and pictures.
- Write a list and draw pictures of words ending with g sound spelt –gue and k sound spelt – que
- Create a poster to help you learn the spelling of words ending with the suffixes -ly, -ness, -ful, -less
- Create a crossword for the Year 3 High Frequency Words.
- Choose 5 different Year 3 High Frequency Words and practice them using strategies from the Spelling Menu.
- Use your reading book to find words with the suffixes -ly, -ness, -ful, -less

READING

- Create your own picture book about tsunamis – it can be fiction or non-fiction.
- Read a non-fiction book about 'Extreme Weather'
- Design a new front cover for a book & label it to explain your design choices
- Create a comic strip or storyboard for a book

- Show numbers doubled and halved.
- Show multiples of 10 using pictures.

- Design a poster explaining non-unit fractions and unit fractions.
- Draw 2, 4, 8 and 16 Times Tables to show the patterns.
- Write your own word problems using fractions and solve them – showing your workings
- Write a recipe for a potion showing the amounts of ingredients using fractions eg: $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of water.
- Using £1, 10p and 1p coins, convert pounds to pence & vice versa. E.g. $\pounds 1.62 = 162p$. Write the values on cards & use to play snap.

SCIENCE

The Human Body/Rocks

- Design a poster on the difference between a human skeleton and an animal skeleton
- Compare lengths of your body with other parts (e.g.: your thumb is the length of your nose)
- Research vertebrae and invertebrate
- Write about how muscles work and why we need them
- Complete an investigation about the human body
- Create your own fossil skeleton
- Design your own dinosaur skeleton

HUMANITIES

Extreme Earth/Anglo Saxons

- Research a natural disaster and create a fact file about it.
- Make your own volcano.
- Make a poster showing what to do if a real earthquake happened.
- Can you find out 10 amazing facts about tsunamis?
- Make up an Anglo-Saxons quiz.
- You are an archaeologist who has dug up a box of Anglo Saxon artefacts. What could be inside? Who did the casket belong to? Did they keep a diary? Write about it.
- Find all the prime numbers up to 31 in Anglo Saxon runes
- Design an Anglo Saxon shield.
