SCIENCE

Amazing Adaptations

- Create an investigation about how long it takes ice to melt in different conditions. Try in a hot room, a cold room and outside. Photograph your experiment.
- Draw out and label the water cycle from memory, without peeking! Then, double check and fill in any blanks you had. How well did you do?
- Design and draw a solar powered car – label your invention.
- Remind yourself about staying safe during experiments – write out some golden rules for staying safe.
- How do penguins keep warm? What about snakes? Research how different animals keep themselves warm.
- What is the cleanest type of energy, and why is it good for the planet?
- Create a 3D model of an atom.
- Research the Chernobyl disaster and what happened.
- Pick an element from the periodic table and make a poster about it.
- Compare two famous scientists and decide which one contributed more to science.
- Perform a science experiment of your own devising.
- Create a paper aeroplane capable of travelling over 10 metres.
- Design a model of the water cycle (bonus points if it actually includes water!).
- Make a lifecycle wheel to show the stages of a lifecycle for a chosen animal.
- Find out about a famous naturalist e.g. Jane Goodall and report to the class what they have studied and discovered.

- Make a poster about the different celebrations Jewish people have.
- Work out the rough ages of each major religion – which religion came first?
- Can you come up with your own Easter video?
- What does religion mean to you?

BRAZIL & RAINFORESTS

- **Rainforest Layers** - Which layer do they think would have the most plants?
- **Rainforest Plant** - Given the different features of a variety of plants in the Rainforest, design a plant which will thrive in the rainforest.

MATHEMATICS

- Complete a TimesTable Challenge – how good are your recall skills.
- Create a poster about a famous mathematician.
- Arranging numbers around squares ...30, 19, 47, 14, 32, 22, 15, 21, 12 Arrange eight of these numbers in a square so that the sides make the following totals: 58, 64, 50, 70. Each number may be used once only.
- There are 11 different ways to produce a net of a cube. Can you find them all?
- How many different combinations of 15 coins can you find that will make exactly £1? Coins may be used more than once.
- There are four different coloured counters arranged in a row. Find all 24 possible combinations.
- Playing with consecutive numbers. $15 = 7 + 8$, $15 = 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 5$, $15 = 4 + 5 + 6$ What about 1, 2, 4, 8, 16, 32, 64?
- Explore the link between the 2, 4 and 8 times table. How does this affect the 16 times table? Are there any others? Explain with evidence.
- You have 4 equilateral triangles. How many different shapes can you make by joining the edges together exactly?
- Draw as many different quadrilaterals as you can on a 3 x 3 dot grid.
- Shopping Problems – create a shopping problem worksheet with 5 questions with a minimum of 5 items for sale? Can you think about some change questions too?

- Invent a new 2 player sport to play with a friend. Write the rules and objective of the game.
- How does working together make our lives easier? Write down 5 times teamwork has helped you in life.
- Imagine if you were the only child in school. How would it be different from normal? Would it be better or worse? Give reasons.
- What professions and jobs can you think of where people **must** work together to succeed.
- Create a flow chart of small goals you need to achieve before making your dream come true
- At the end of each day for a week complete *3-2-1 Exercise* (3. What are three things I've learned? 2. What are two things I still want to learn?)
- Write a short story about a time when you failed and you did not give up to carry on learning something.

- Research Shakespeare and his life then write a fact file about him.
