Pre-Reception

Children can join the term after their 3rd birthday and must attend a minimum of five morning sessions (8am-1pm). Additional afternoon sessions can be added, one single session is considered 1pm to 6pm. The morning session includes a hot lunch. Own packed lunches can be brought in, but we are unable to offer a discount.

Reception to Y6

The fees include tuition fees, hot lunches, after school clubs, weekly swimming, wrap around care from 8am - 6pm and termly educational school trips (including residential) and workshops. Also included are all class tuition exercise books, library books and basic stationery. All on-site sports and travel to and from school matches are included.

All fees are payable by:

2nd September – Autumn Term

2nd January – Spring Term

2nd April – Summer Term

- Fees are subject to alteration and an annual increase should be expected.
- Information about alternative/monthly payments through an external provider can be discussed with the Bursar
- No reduction is made for absence
- Fees are payable by BACS

Admission Fee:

A one-off Admission Fee of £300 is due to reserve your child's place at Lyndhurst which is non-refundable.

Discounts (only one discount can be claimed per child).

- Sibling Discount 10% second child and 15% third and subsequent children.
- *Services Discount 10% first child and 15% for second and subsequent children.

Notice periods:

Please note that

- Two full terms' notice, in writing to the Headmaster is required to leave the school for pupils in Pre-Reception.
- One full term's notice, in writing to the Headmaster is required to leave the school for pupils in Pre-Prep and Prep.
- Half a term's notice is required for cancelling any confirmed optional classes (e.g., 1-1 Music lessons and learning support lessons).

Childcare vouchers:

Tax-free childcare vouchers can only be used against the hours that fall outside of the normal School Day "educational hours" (morning & after school element).

Early Years' Grants:

Lyndhurst School participates in the Government Early Education Scheme, offering 15 hours & 30 hours grants depending on the sessions attended and eligibility. This applies for up to six terms, commencing the term after a pupil's 3rd birthday. The grants are calculated depending on how many days/weeks are in each term.
