Children must attend the minimum five morning sessions between the hours of 8am-1.30pm. Additional afternoon sessions can be added staring from 1.30pm until 6pm. We can advise on the number of sessions that will suit the needs of your family.

Early Years' Grants:

Lyndhurst School participates in the Government Early Education Scheme, offering 15 hours & 30 hours grants depending on the session attended and eligibility. This applies for up to six terms, commencing the term after a pupil's 3rd birthday. The grants are calculated depending on how many days/weeks are in each term.

The termly educational fee encompasses a range of provisions, including:

- Educational fees
- Termly educational workshops.
- All class tuition, exercise books, library books, basic stationery, and equipment.
- All on-site sports and travel to and from school matches within the UK
- Educational one-day trips within the UK during normal school days
- Weekly swimming lessons
- Residential field trips for pupils in Years 5 and 6

Termly Food Charge £792.85 – This charge applies to all pupils and is a standard part of the termly fees. We are dedicated to providing our children with all snacks and lunches that are not only wholesome, nutritious, and well-balanced but also delicious and enjoyable. Each day, children are offered a variety of lunch dishes, including a vegetarian option, ensuring that all dietary preferences are catered for. We also offer a sport afternoon snacks and sandwich snack for those staying past 5pm.

Childcare Provision

We provide childcare services during the following times: Morning session operates from 08.00 to 09.00 Registration: Children must arrive by 08.25 to ensure they are properly registered

Afternoon session operates from 15.45-18.00 Includes an afternoon sandwich snack for the children at 17.10 Collection time from 16.00/ 17.00 or 17.30

These childcare services are designed to support parents by offering a safe and structured environment for children outside regular school hours.

VAT Application

- Educational fees: including VAT
- Termly food charge, childcare provision and childcare based holiday clubs: 0% VAT, as these services are exempt.
- Extra-Curricular activities will be subject to VAT.
- Pre-Reception classes for children below the compulsory school age of 5 (if 90% or more of the class are under 5) will also remain VAT-exempt.



- Fees are subject to alteration and an annual increase should be expected.
- Information about alternative/monthly payments through an external provider can be discussed with the Bursar
- No reduction is made for absence
- Fees are payable by BACS

Admission Fee:

An Admission Fee of £360 is due within seven days once a place has been offered to reserve your child's place at Lyndhurst which is non-refundable.

Discounts (only one discount can be claimed per child).

- Sibling Discount 10% second child and 15% third and subsequent children.
- *Services Discount 10% first child and 15% for second and subsequent children.

*Services: military, ambulance, fire, police, NHS (ID required)

Notice periods:

Please note that

- Two full terms' notice, in writing to the Headmaster, is required to leave the school for pupils in Pre-Reception.
- One full term's notice, in writing to the Headmaster is required to leave the school for pupils in Pre-Prep and Prep.
- Half a term's notice is required for cancelling confirmed optional classes (e.g., 1-1 Music lessons and learning support lessons).

Childcare vouchers:

We accept vouchers from the following:

Tax-free childcare vouchers can only be used against the childcare provision element . We always advise parents to double check with HMRC what amount exactly they can pay through vouchers, these can be redeemed if eligible up to the age of 11. Vouchers can be used against the hours that fall outside of the normal school day (Childcare/Morning & After school and childcare based holiday clubs)
